1. The Sheridan WYO Rodeo will be requiring a current 30-day Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (health inspection) on all animals including livestock and pets coming onto the Sheridan County Fairgrounds, during the Sheridan WYO Rodeo. Along with this health inspection, we will require all horses to have a negative Coggins within twelve months. This paperwork will be required for all animals whether they are coming from an out of state premise or an instate premise. Papers may be checked at the gate or on the premises.
2. **Parking** is challenging on the grounds, but we do have parking in the **infield** and in the **north end** of the arena, just off 5th St. During the slack in the mornings, parking is available on the north and south ends of the carnival but need to be moved by 3:00pm each day. PLEASE no parking is allowed on the “track”. Any vehicles or trailers parked and left on the track will be towed at owner’s expense.
3. **Stalls** are very limited, first-come-first serve, please call **Austin Reutzel** at **307-575-7590**. PLEASE - no portable panels or electric fences with be allowed in parking areas or on the track.
4. We have a **complimentary meal ticket** for contestants at the tent next to the Rodeo Office. You can get that ticket from the Rodeo Secretary. In addition, we have **complimentary water** for all contestants. There are coolers at the **timed event boxes**, behind the **rough stock chutes** on both sides, and the **catch pen** for timed events on the north end of the arena.
